The National High School Rodeo Association (NHSRA) is an international, non-profit organization dedicated to the development of sportsmanship, horsemanship, and the sport of rodeo. In 1947 Claude Mullins started the NHSRA, and the first National Finals were held in Hallettsville Texas.

Since the start of the NHSRA, membership has grown significantly. In 1947 the finals featured 121 contestants and now over 1,500 contestants compete annually. The High School National Finals are known as the World's Largest Rodeo!

NJ members compete at the state level for a chance to qualify for their spot at the Nationals Finals. The top 4 from each event in the High School and Junior High divisions earn the opportunity to compete at the National Finals.
